The autocratic or communist type political & Economic systems are required to pay more than double or as determined by global organization call “GoD’. The X is determined by GoD every year.

The ACCORDs determined participating countries shall be valid for 2 (two) years. Any party to the accord can challenge and negotiate the accord before 2 years are up. The challenging party is required to $1000B_{\infty}$ [$1B_{\infty} = \$1000$]. However, this required fee to renegotiate the Accord before it expires, will be increased by minimum 5% or more as determined by GoD.

Any accord will have two parts, Part A non-negotiable terms and then Part B negotiable terms. The renewal fee for any accord after its validity date will be $1(B_{\infty})$.

What’s B_{∞} , it’s value will be always equal to 1kilograms of the value of (300 grams of 24 carat gold+300 grams of pure 99.99% silver + 400 grams of pure copper).
