B- BLENDING IN

A- ALL OVER THE PLACE

- You believe that more offers = more value.

N- NEGLECTING OFFLINE SELF

You look great online but lack confidence in person.

Why?

- You believe presence is about performance, not wellness.
- You focus on digital polish because it feels safer and more controllable.
- Offline, your health and energy are neglected because you think branding is online only.

D- DISCONNECT FROM VALUES

You're copying industry norms instead of expressing yourself.

Why?

- You've been told there's a "right way" to sound credible or professional.
- So you shape-shift to match trends or echo others.
- You fear that your real story won't be taken seriously, so you hide it.
