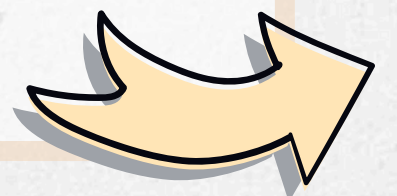
"I don't have any weaknesses"

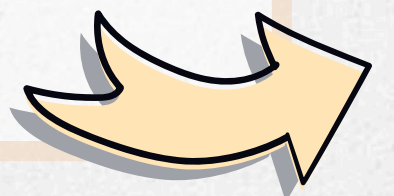
"I hate my current boss"

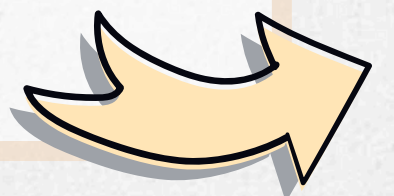
"I'll take any salary"
